


2021 YEAR IN REVIEW

By connecting donors to nonprofits, programs, and causes, NCCF aims to serve as a catalyst for positive change in Norton County. NCCF continues to be a critical player in community development, assisting in initiatives such as Leadership Norton County and the Station 15 Podcast, as well as managing the historic Heaton Building.

ASSET DISTRIBUTION



FOR THE YEAR OF 2021

- 38 grants totaling \$256,967 awarded in Norton County.
- \$15,700 in scholarships awarded to Norton County students.
- \$149,447 given to nonprofits/charitable projects through Match Day.
- \$158,677.02 raised for NCCF's grant endowment through Match Month.
- Nearly \$15,000 in impact investing dollars at work in local businesses.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

After facilitating a county-wide survey and roundtable discussion about the need for additional childcare providers in Norton County, NCCF announced the In-Home Childcare Start-Up Loan program in October. The program provides loans for capital expenses needed to open a new, in-home childcare facility. To date, NCCF has issued loans to help open two new facilities, impacting the families and employers of approximately twenty children. Learn more here.
